The day to day life of all residents is going on very smoothly and we are always thankful for countless blessings from God and grateful for all your unconditional support.



After a great deal of hard work, all the plans to start the dairy farm came to a reality! The dairy farm is situated on four acres of land with a barn to accommodate 20 water buffaloes. Ten buffaloes arrived in the third week of September, and we are waiting for the arrival of 10 more



buffaloes next week. The new project will be a great source of income generation and will help us to attain self-sufficiency for the running of Nora's Home. I sincerely thank and appreciate your generosity, especially for "Helping to Prove Ma Wrong!"
